



ECWORK - ECVET for work-based learning is an ERASMUS + funded project which was carried out, between October 2016 and September 2018, by six partners from several EU countries. The main goal of the project was the application of ECVET methodology in the field of practical training for students at the international level, the recognition of the ECVET points and the standardization of learning outcomes for practical training.

The project involved two vocational schools (Electromechanical School from Varaždin, Croatia, and FORAVE, from Lousado, Portugal) and four adult education institutions from Greece (IIEK Delta, Athens and IDEK, from Piraeus), Cyprus (Polytechnic Intercollege, Nicosia) and Spain (Fondo Formacion Euskadi SLL, from Bilbao).

During the two-year project, the partners produced three intellectual outputs (a guide for companies, a guide for teachers and a students' toolkit) to help other institutions to implement the same type of project, held four project meetings and a course training in the field of ECVET methodology, and, finally, **two** students from each school had a work-based learning period in one of the partner countries.

The Employers' Guide is addressed to employers providing work-placements for foreign students and helps them on how to design and monitor a work-placement. The Teachers' Guide is addressed to VET teachers and trainers and has all the information needed on how to organise transnational work-placements for students, using the ECVET framework. Both include information and practical tools - guidelines, templates, and checklists. Finally, the Students' Toolkit is a set of tools aiming at supporting students in organising their work-placement abroad.

All these guides are translated into all the partners' languages and are published on the project website - <http://ecwork.eu> alongside the work-based learning periods' results.

The final meeting of the Steering and Technical Committees, and the Final Project Conference took place in Varazdin, Croatia on 26th and 27th October 2018.
