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What did we try to achieve?

- ▶ To develop a set of useful tools and methodology for implementing ECVET for transnational work based learning (practical training abroad) - especially in the field of electromechanics.
- ▶ To facilitate the formation of ECVET partnerships i.e. Collaboration between institutions who can function as intermediary bodies for facilitating transnational work-based learning.





What problems did we encounter?

- ❑ Understanding each other's study programmes e.g. learning outcomes, assessment methods etc.
- ❑ Creating a common understanding between the intermediary bodies about the practical training.
- ❑ Overcoming national/legal complexities for transnational practical training.





Best Practice

- ▶ The concept of “ECVET Partnerships”
 - ▶ Forming a partnership with another institution in a foreign country serving as an intermediary body for the practical training.
 - ▶ The intermediary body serves as a link between the sending institution, the student while abroad and the company abroad.
 - ▶ It makes the process of transnational practical training easier and safeguards the quality of the mobility.
