



Second press release, October 2017

The 2nd Steering Committee & Technical Committee Meeting took place in Bilbao, Spain from 20 to 21st of September 2017. During this meeting the partners discussed about the fulfilment of some of the objectives of ECWORK project such as the Teacher's Guide, The Employer's Guide and the Student's toolkit.



The second intellectual output of ECWORK project is the Teacher's guide. Teachers guide is a guide addressed to VET teachers and trainers on how to organise transnational work-placements for students, using ECVET framework. It includes short information and practical tools – guidelines, templates, checklists. The Teacher's Guide for the Implementation of ECVET transnational work based learning is ready.

The third intellectual output of the project is the Employer's guide. Employers guide is addressed to employers providing work-placements for foreign students on how to design and monitor work-placement. It includes short information and practical tools – guidelines, templates, checklists on how to assess learning outcomes. The Employer's Guide for Designing and providing work-based learning for foreign students is ready.

Both of the Guides will be continuously updated/improved throughout the project duration - with partner feedback from the ECVET implementation and pilot delivery. The final versions of the two guides will be published on the [project website](#) for valorization at national and European level. The guides are drafted and completed in English, and then will be translated into all partners' languages.

The fourth intellectual output is the Student's toolkit. Students' toolkit is a set of tools aiming at supporting students in organising their work-placement abroad. The tools will be published as a guide and as separate tools, downloadable from the web-site. The Toolkit for students, to facilitate and support them in transnational mobility and work-based learning is still a work in progress.

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The Toolkit will be evaluated after pilot delivery using evaluation questionnaires for students, employers and teachers/ trainers. FORAVE, as leader of evaluation activities, will draft the questionnaire in English and summarise the feedback from all partners in an overall evaluation report. The Toolkit will be updated/ improved based on the results and recommendations of this report and a new version of the Toolkit will be published on the project website for valorization at national and European level.

During this meeting, the partners also planned the mobility tht will take place in the first semmerster of 2018.
